- Debrief for 2025 SMDP MedTech training, October 3-8, San Diego, CA
  - o Agenda The SMDP MedTech Scholars received mentoring portal training while the mentors discussed plans for the virtual mentoring year; overall feedback was positive; Mentors suggested that ICPD provide feedback to the mentors at the end of the year of mentoring; due to the scheduling of the AdvaMed Convention the program started on a Friday instead of Saturday, it will be that way in 2026 as well.
  - Scholars: 30 SMDP Medtech Scholars sponsored (budget of 30)
  - Mentors: 18 in-person mentors, 3 stand-in mentors in-person and 12 virtual mentors (11 in 2024); 6 of the 12 virtual mentors joined 1:1 meetings; the virtual 1:1 session worked well; for the scholars whose mentors did not attend the in-person or virtual 1:1 sessions, then ICPD doubled those scholars with another onsite mentor; mentors who can't attend in-person should be available for virtual 1:1 sessions
  - Venues all worked well; Punch Bowl Social worked very well for networking and everyone seemed to enjoy the karaoke and bowling; the Embassy Suites Bayfront was a very good facility for the training and scholar lodging
  - o Celebration of Mentoring and Diversity Reception group photo should be added for the future events
  - o Site visits Thanks to JLabs San Diego for hosting a site visit; it gave the scholars insights into the emerging companies ecosystem
  - o Group size ICPD provided QR codes at the training and events to allow attendees to "sign-in" with their cell phones

- Objective criteria now includes "disadvantaged backgrounds," as defined here: <a href="https://www.era.nih.gov/commons/disadvantaged\_def.htm">https://www.era.nih.gov/commons/disadvantaged\_def.htm</a>
- Objective criterion also includes: Is currently enrolled at or received a degree from an accredited United States of Puerto Rico based institution of higher education, and the applicants will be required to submit their most recent transcript and it should be no more than 3 years old
