#### **ELISA Summit Committee (Marie-Ange Noue, Chair)**

Last meeting was 6 August 2025

- Focus Discussion
  - o Resources feature
    - Overview of how the "Jobs" feature functions on the SMDP portal; what type of resources will members want to share and what are the categories of these resources (ie services, funding opportunities, etc)?; will posted resources be curated by staff or the membership?; will posted resources be visible only to the membership or to the public?; benchmark against other models such as Opportunity Desk
    - The committee recommends having a separate tool for "Resources" where users can post and share resources. An important characteristic is how quick and simple it is to create and offer a resource. Fields to be: 1. type of resource (ie services, funding opportunities, etc); 2. does the user want the posted resource to appear on their profile and/or their project page?; 3. price (optional); only members of the ELISA Business Portal should be able to create and post resources, but the public can view posted resources. Staff will monitor the resources and reserve the right to remove posted resources.

## **ELISA Portal Committee (Chudi Obiaya, Chair)**

Last meeting was 5 August 2025

- Focus Topic
  - o **Resources feature** 
    - Should allow users to comment on individual resources
    - Recommend using a structure similar to the SMDP "Jobs" page
    - Some of the resource categories should be: funding opportunities, mentors, jobs/hiring, technology
    - Provide a way to contact the person who posted the resource
    - To be able to post a resource a user needs to be a member of the ELISA Business Network Portal
    - Staff to consider how posts are "policed"
  - Objectives for the ELISA portal membership of the portal survey results; need for public and member side of the portal objectives?; update goals to reflect stickiness and organic growth? The committee refined the objectives and suggested these:
    - Enhancement of member engagement within the portal so that the average time members spend on the portal each visit increases by 10% per year and the frequency of their visits increases by 10% per year
    - Networking amongst entrepreneurs and ELISA members so that the number of connections members are making are increasing at a rate of 10% per year
    - Seek and engage entrepreneurs with a growing collection of free resources for entrepreneurs

- Project pages make events shareable; allow Project page owners to see who has viewed
  their project; searching and filtering of the pages; posting of resources and opportunities
  (including miscellaneous posts by category such as funding opportunities, services, goods,
  etc.), while being mindful of curation and security; enhance the functionality of adding
  team members; crowd funding for project pages (with feedback system)
- Members Onboarding process; members to see who has viewed their profile; rewards system; prospective members - enrollment process streamlined

- Focus topics
  - o 2025-2026 ELISA Business Scholars (EBS) program sponsorship
    - Sponsorship ICPD invites committee members who are available to coach;

    - ecosystem development and inclusion
    - program delivery and satisfaction
    - innovation and product development
    - sustainability and long-term impact
  - o We still are in need of a Chair for the Development Committee
