 - **Training Session was held 12-15 Nov 2024, in Hwange, Zimbabwe**
 - **Scholars - represented a good cross-section of sectors and countries; bringing the group together in-person provided highly impactful engagements**
 - **Coaches - were effective, however staff recommends a 1:1 matching as opposed to 2:1; seek to have all coaches in-person at the training session**
 - **Agenda - good balance of business skills, coaching, practical planning and work on the scholar's businesses**
 - **Logistics - integrate the Victoria Falls experience into the last day; pre-book airline tickets at least one month prior to the event; visa issues and yellow fever vaccinations**
 - **Virtual coaching - getting coaching plans online**
